## TUNA \$1,000 SUPER CALCUTTA

FOR HEAVIEST QUALIFYING TUNA (60% 1ST PLACE, 40% 2ND PLACE)

- In the event that only one qualifying fish is caught in the Tuna Super Calcutta, all money will be awarded to the 1st place Tuna entrant.
- If there is a tie for 1st place in the Tuna Super Calcutta, winner will be determined by the date and time caught. If there is a tie for 2nd place in the Tuna Super Calcutta, the tie splits the 2nd place money.
- In the event there is no qualifying tuna caught in the Tuna Super Calcutta, all prize money will be refunded to all entrants of the Tuna Super Calcutta.
